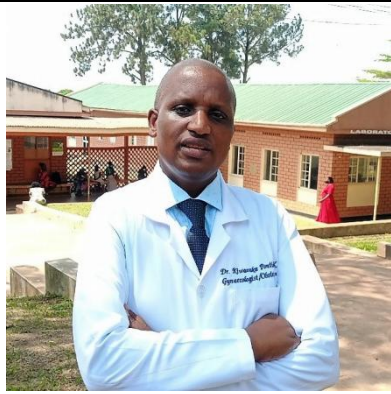

AFTER SEVERAL YEARS OF NEGLECT ,HE GOT MALNOURISHED AND CRIPPLED THUS FAILING TO ACHIEVE HIS DEVELOPMENTAL MILE STONES IN TIME.

CURRENTLY HE STAYS WITH HIS FATHER IN NSENGE VILLAGE SO FAR FOR FOR ONE



AND A HALF YEARS.

AT THE MOMENT HE'S ABLE TO WALK AND WITH A GOOD SENSE OF HEARING DESPITE BEING UNABLE TO TALK AND BEING MODERATELY MAL-NOURISHED.

WAMBUKHU'S FATHER APPROACHED US AT THE OUTREACH IN SEARCH FOR MEDICAL ATTENTION FOR HIS SON WHICH HE'D LISTENED FROM THE COMMUNITY MEGAPHONE ABOUT THE HEALTH PROMOTION PROGRAMME BY MISSION UGANDA IN CONJUNCTION WITH ST. FRANCIS NYENGA PARISH AND ST. FRANCIS HOSPITAL NYENGA

THE BOY PRESENTED WITH A SWOLLEN BELLY AND FAILURE TO TALK (IN HIS FATHER'S WORDS)

HE WAS GRACEFULLY RECEIVED BY THE HEALTH WORKERS ON SITE, HAD HIS NUTRITIONAL STATUS ASSESSED AND MANAGED ACCORDINGLY.

A FOLLOW-UP PLAN HAS BEEN DEVISED AND WITH MUCH HOPE WAMBUKHU WILL BE HEALTHY AGAIN IN NO TIME
